Chairman Christy Ward called the regular meeting of the Adams County Planning Commission to order at 7:00 p.m. on August 19, 2013 in the courtroom in the Adams County Courthouse.

Chairman Ward informed the other commission members that Brad Dryer had resigned. There was a discussion of possible replacements for him. A new board member must live within the New Meadows city limits.

Don Horton told commission members that his office is seeing an increase in building permits, but nothing has come in that needs to come before the board. He had ordered new manuals for everyone, but they have not arrived yet.

Jeff Batten was absent.

Rich Laine presented an issue that the city is having with a piece of property that an owner wants to split. The difficulty lies with an abandoned alley way that was deeded to another land owner. This took place several years ago. Commission members agreed that the request would have to be denied.

Mickie Eby asked Don to investigate a possible salvage yard being operated in Adams County. Don said he would check out the situation and talk to the person involved to find out what is happening.

The minutes from the July 15, 2013 meeting were reviewed and Steve Ryals moved that the minutes be approved with three spelling corrections. Bill Shore seconded the motion, which passed with everyone present voting in favor of the motion.
