Goodrich Landfill: Jim McLeod stated the monitoring well is completed; depth 163 feet with two gallons per minute. Testing of the well water will be completed soon.

Leachate Water-Pumping Tanks: The tanks will not be pumped this year due to the new design of the drainage system.

Snow Maintenance of Underutilized Roads: Supervisor Spelman discussed roads that could potentially be not plowed in the future due to not being used by the public.

After discussion, Joe Holmes, Commissioner, made a motion to approve an increase from \$18.16 per hour to \$18.70 per hour. Mike E. Paradis, Commissioner, seconded the motion. The motion passed unanimously by voice vote.

SHERIFF MATTERS: Present Sheriff Ryan Zollman.

Jail: The County Jail houses currently 27 inmates.

911 North Repeater: Sheriff Zollman discussed moving responsibility for the repeater to the New Meadows Emergency Services since they are the entity that uses the repeater. After discussion, Joe Holmes, Commissioner, made a motion to approve relinquishing responsibility of the repeater to New Meadows Emergency Services. Mike E. Paradis seconded the motion. The motion passed unanimously by voice vote. A letter will be prepared and sent on behalf of the Board.

Sheriff Side – Heat Pump: The Sheriff informed the Board a relay is bad in the unit and will be replaced. The Board directed the Sheriff to get the system fixed.

OLD COURTHOUSE STRUCTURAL CONCERNS: Present were the following: Building Inspector Don Horton, Elaine and Pete Johnston.

Don Horton stated he reviewed the Old Courthouse and had noticed several serious concerns about the structural integrity of the building. Don Horton stated to the Board that it is in the best interest of the County to condemn the building. A claim with ICRMP will be filed; an insurance adjuster will review the building along with an engineer. Don went on to state the outside walls have no rebar. Therefore, nothing is holding the building together. No one should be allowed into the building. Commissioner Mike Paradis stated the health and safety of the community are most important. After discussion, Joe Holmes, Commissioner, made a motion to approve condemning the Old Courthouse pending further investigation by an insurance adjuster and engineer. Mike Paradis seconded the motion. The motion passed unanimously by voice vote.

WEED DEPARTMENT WEEKLY LOG: February 13 - February 24, 2017

February 13, 2017: Spread ice melt on the remaining icy patches at the Courthouse parking lot. Called Dave Lister at Bio West to find out more about the labeling investigation that ISDA called me about on Dec 20. Mr. Lister maintains that the product will perform as advertised and that the disagreement with ISDA is a matter of definitions. He also told me that the situation is ongoing as ISDA and Bio West are still in discussions. He agreed to keep me informed of further developments. Worked on the NOI for EPA, sent an email with some of my questions regarding the Endangered Species portions of the application to Dirk Helder in Boise.

February 14, 2017: PTO; phone w/ ITD regarding CWMA sign location; phone w/ USFS regarding Modification for 2017 season.

February 15, 2017: Meeting at the Courthouse for the Medical Savings Account program. Weed study and continued review of information from the Weed Conference in January. Received a response from Dirk Helder suggesting that the federal agencies were working on procedures for counties with Endangered Species concerns, and suggesting that I wait a short time for a response from his office with guidance. Begin review of proposed legislation amending the state invasive species program.

February 16, 2017: Freezing rain conditions this morning, so I spread ice melt on the sidewalks and on the parking lot. Continue review of proposed legislation. Start a news article for Invasive Species Awareness Week.

February 17, 2017: Ice at the Courthouse. Complete and submit newspaper article for The Record. PTO in the afternoon.

February 20, 2017: President's Day Holiday.


