Asked for 10 thousand but they did not have it. Bought a new gurney for 40 Thousand Dollies. EMS state was supposed to give a grant for it. Would have to make a payment till state came through. Had not gotten yet because of COVID-19. We were told to wait a month or two and apply again, 12 Thousand Dollars. One payment has been made and have two more to make, and its ours. Covid-19 has made it hard. Applied for Cares grant. Which was 6 thousand. Need a new Life Pack so went threw the same company as the gurney. Which was 25 thousand. Cares money is still on the way. Did get a letter stating we were getting it. Did d get 25 thousand to pay off the gurney. Reason no money threw the commissioners they did not apply due to Covid-19. Doing fine finically.

EMT classes are going well. Hoping to get 4 out of the 4 to pass the state exam. Last class will be April 28. Then will have to wait to see when state can test. May test with Midvale and Cambridge.
