


Public Hearing –Bear Fire Protection District Dissolution



A petition has been filed to dissolve the Bear Fire Protection District. A public hearing will be on Tuesday, January 22, 2019 at 1:30 p.m., in the courtroom, Adams County Courthouse, Council, Idaho. Any taxpayer within the district boundaries, may appear at the hearing and testify and/or present

exhibits upon any issue pertaining to the proposed dissolution of the fire district or may object to or support the proposed dissolution.

The boundaries of the Bear Fire Protection District are as follows: BEGINNING at a point where the south line of Adams County intersects at the Snake River in Sec. 1, T. 17 N., R. 5W. B.M., and running thence north along the

east side of the Snake River to its intersection with the north line of Sec. 17, T21N., R. 3W., B.M.; thence east on the section lines approximately 16 ½ miles to the northeast corner of Sec. 13, T.21N., R.1W. B.M.; thence south on the township line 4 miles to the southeast corner of Sec. 36, said township and range; thence west on the township line 6 miles to the northeast corner of Sec. 1, T.20N., R.2W., B.M.; thence south on Township line 9 ½ miles to the east quarter of Sec. 24, T.19N., R.2W., B.M.; thence west through center of section 6 miles to the West Quarter corner of Sec. 19, T.19N., R. 2W., B.M.; thence south on the township line 9 miles to the county line; thence west on and long the county line to the point of beginning.
