

ADAMS COUNTY ORDINANCE NO. 2006-1

AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING MAXIMUM SPEED LIMITS ON COUNTY ROADS; PROHIBITING UNAUTHROIZED SIGNS; ESTABLISHING PENALTIES FOR VIOLATIONS; REPEALING ORDINANCE 1992-4; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE

BE IT ORDAINED by the Board of Commissioners of Adams County, Idaho as follows:

1. Speed limits established.

A. Maximum speed limit of 35 miles per hour shall apply to all county roads within Adams County unless otherwise posted by Order of the Board of Commissioners of Adams County, Idaho.

B. Other maximum speed limits shall be set by resolution of the Board of Commissioners and posted after consideration of the physical condition of the roadway, traffic volume, and special hazards existing in any portion of the county road system.

2. Unauthorized signs or devices prohibited.


A. The Board of Commissioners of Adams County shall authorize traffic control signs and devices within the county road system by resolution. All unauthorized traffic control signs, devices, speed bumps, or gates are prohibited in or upon Adams County roads, right-of-ways and bridges.

B. It shall be unlawful for anyone to place unauthorized traffic control signs, devices, speed-bumps, or gates within the Adams County road system and it is punishable by a fine of \$100.00 per day for each day such unauthorized sign or device remains.

B. This Ordinance shall repeal and replace Ordinance No. 1992-4. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect upon its passage and publication in a newspaper of general circulation within Adams County, Idaho.


