

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN, That the Board of County Commissioners of Adams County, Idaho will receive and publicly open, sealed and clearly marked bids for drilling, blasting and crushing 20,000 tons of ¾" minus gravel to be in one stockpile and 2,000 tons of 3" cap rock in one stockpile in the Council area to be completed by October 31st, 2019. Adams County will be doing quality control testing on the material produced. The material produced needs to be stored on site until such time as Adams County uses up the stockpiles. Adams County will pay for this project after Oct. 1st, 2019.

Adams County will require a bid bond equal to 5% (percent) of the amount bid. Adams County requires a 3% (percent) performance bond from the successful bidder and copies of liability and workman's comp. insurance as well as a valid public works license. Bidder must have certified belt or platform scales for weighing. The pit being used shall have a current conditional use permit from Adams County and a current reclamation plan with Idaho Dept. of Lands. The successful bidder will be required to sign a contract with Adams County.
